Subject: Inspection and Service Requirements For NANO-LOK SRL's

Nano-Lok (self-retracting lifelines), as well as all other type 1, 2 and 3 devices, should be inspected before and after each use and every 6 months by a height safety equipment inspector (competent person), as per AS/NZS 1891.4. Follow the user manual provided by the manufacturer for inspection guidelines and check the device for the following:

- SRL locking function by pulling sharply on line to test
- Line retraction function
- Condition of cable or webbing
- Condition of connectors, housing and fasteners
- Legibility of labels
- Any evidence of defects, damage or missing parts
- Inspect shock absorber for signs of rupture or deployment

The product must be immediately withdrawn from service if it does not meet inspection criteria or if it has been involved in a fall.

Since 2012, the Nano-Lok SRL's pictured below carry a limited lifetime warranty against manufacturer defects in materials and workmanship, however they are ***not serviceable***. 'Lifetime' in this case is defined to a period of up to **5 years**, in accordance with Section 9 of the Australian New Zealand Standard (AS/NZS 1891.4), provided they continue to pass defined inspection requirements.
